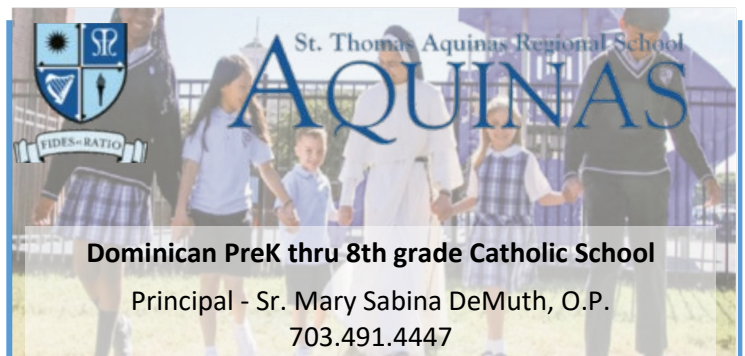

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear parishioners,

I would like to welcome and introduce Mrs. Jovanna Cooper, who joined the staff at Our Lady of Angels Parish on February 2, 2026. Fluent in both Spanish and English, Jovanna will work in the parish office as a full-time administrative assistant. She comes to OLA with professional experience in office administration, executive support, and financial operations. She holds a Bachelor of Business Administration degree. Please join me in giving Jovanna a very warm welcome. Don't hesitate to stop by the parish office to introduce yourself and say hello!



The recent snow and ice storm was both challenging and fruitful. Let me share some thoughts that came from my reflection and prayer.

1. The storm reminded us that God is in charge. Although the ice damaged our gym roof and created a new maintenance need for our parish and school, we count our beautiful campus as a great gift from God. Nonetheless, we hired a company to urgently remediate the ice dam, which has caused many leaks. Although the roof's structure is solid, we will need to install new shingles. Lesson learned: God has the final say in our ongoing maintenance improvements. We are grateful for your prayers and recurring parish maintenance donations.
2. The storm strengthened our teamwork between the parish and school. Aquinas Principal Sister Mary Sabina, OP, and I have mobilized our teams and volunteers. Next weekend, we will hold the rescheduled second collection for Aquinas. This would be a great opportunity to support the parish and school.
3. The overwhelming presence of ice on campus helped me better understand what happens in the human heart. The shady areas suffered the most damage from the storm because they were away from the warming effect of the sun. Similarly, isolation and loneliness are comparable to those shaded areas. It is there that the ice hardens our hearts. Only through patience and exposure to warmer temperatures will that ice melt. Only through prayer in the presence of Christ, the sun that rises from above, will our hearts regain their vigor and flexibility.



Finally, cooperate as much as possible with our bishop's Lenten appeal. Today is Commitment Weekend. In Christ, we are one through many pledges.
