

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners,

On this fourth Sunday of Lent, I offer you this reflection. It is a wonderful sermon by Saint Peter Chrysologus, bishop.

“There are three things, my brethren, by which faith stands firm, devotion remains constant, and virtue endures. They are prayer, fasting and mercy. Prayer knocks at the door, fasting obtains, mercy receives. Prayer, mercy and fasting: these three are one, and they give life to each other.

Fasting is the soul of prayer, mercy is the lifeblood of fasting. Let no one try to separate them; they cannot be separated. If you have only one of them or not all together, you have nothing. So if you pray, fast; if you fast, show mercy; if you want your petition to be heard, hear the petition of others. If you do not close your ear to others you open God's ear to yourself.

When you fast, see the fasting of others. If you want God to know that you are hungry, know that another is hungry. If you hope for mercy, show mercy. If you look for kindness, show kindness. If you want to receive, give. If you ask for yourself what you deny to others, your asking is a mockery. Let this be the pattern for all men when they practice mercy: show mercy to others in the same way, with the same generosity, with the same promptness, as you want others to show mercy to you.

Therefore, let prayer, mercy and fasting be one single plea to God on our behalf, one speech in our defense, a threefold united prayer in our favor.

Let us use fasting to make up for what we have lost by despising others. Let us offer our souls in sacrifice by means of fasting. There is nothing more pleasing that we can offer to God, as the psalmist said in prophecy: A sacrifice to God is a broken spirit; God does not despise a bruised and humbled heart. Offer your soul to God, make him an oblation of your fasting, so that your soul may be a pure offering, a holy sacrifice, a living victim, remaining your own and at the same time made over to God. Whoever fails to give this to God will not be excused, for if you are to give him yourself you are never without the means of giving.


To make these acceptable, mercy must be added. Fasting bears no fruit unless it is watered by mercy. Fasting dries up when mercy dries up. Mercy is to fasting as rain is to the earth. However much you may cultivate your heart, clear the soil of your nature, root out vices, sow virtues, if you do not release the springs of mercy, your fasting will bear no fruit.

When you fast, if your mercy is thin your harvest will be thin; when you fast, what you pour out in mercy overflows into your barn. Therefore, do not lose by saving, but gather in by scattering. Give to the poor, and you give to yourself. You will not be allowed to keep what you have refused to give to others.”

God bless you with renewed strength this Lent,

CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Queridos feligreses,

En este cuarto domingo de Cuaresma, les ofrezco esta reflexión. Se trata de un maravilloso sermón de San Pedro Crisólogo, obispo.

“Tres son, hermanos, los resortes que hacen que la fe se mantenga firme, la devoción sea constante, y la virtud permanente. Estos tres resortes son: la oración, el ayuno y la misericordia. Porque la oración llama, el ayuno intercede, la misericordia recibe. Oración, misericordia y ayuno constituyen una sola y única cosa, y se vitalizan recíprocamente.

El ayuno, en efecto, es el alma de la oración, y la misericordia es la vida del ayuno. Que nadie trate de dividirlos, pues no pueden separarse. Quien posee uno solo de los tres, si al mismo tiempo no posee los otros, no posee ninguno. Por tanto, quien ora, que ayune; quien ayuna, que se compadezca; que preste oídos a quien le suplica aquel que, al suplicar, desea que se le oiga, pues Dios presta oído a quien no cierra los suyos al que le suplica.

Que el que ayuna entienda bien lo que es el ayuno; que preste atención al hambriento quien quiere que Dios preste atención a su hambre; que se compadezca quien espera misericordia; que tenga piedad quien la busca; que responda quien desea que Dios le responda a él. Es un indigno suplicante quien pide para sí lo que niega a otro.

Díctate a ti mismo la norma de la misericordia, de acuerdo con la manera, la cantidad y la rapidez con que quieres que tengan misericordia contigo. Compadécete tan pronto como quisieras que los otros se compadezcan de ti.

En consecuencia, la oración, la misericordia y el ayuno deben ser como un único intercesor en favor nuestro ante Dios, una única llamada, una única y triple petición.

Recobremos con ayunos lo que perdimos por el desprecio; inmolemos nuestras almas con ayunos, porque no hay nada mejor que podamos ofrecer a Dios, de acuerdo con lo que el profeta dice: Mi sacrificio es un espíritu quebrantado: un corazón quebrantado y humillado tú no lo desprecias. Hombre, ofrece a Dios tu alma, y ofrece la oblación del ayuno, para que sea una hostia pura, un sacrificio santo, una víctima viviente, provechosa para ti y acepta a Dios. Quien no dé esto a Dios no tendrá excusa, porque no hay nadie que no se posea a sí mismo para darse.


Mas, para que estas ofrendas sean aceptadas, tiene que venir después la misericordia; el ayuno no germina si la misericordia no lo riega, el ayuno se torna infructuoso si la misericordia no lo fecundiza: lo que es la lluvia para la tierra, eso mismo es la misericordia para el ayuno. Por más que perfeccione su corazón, purifique su carne, desarraigue los vicios y siembre las virtudes, como no produzca caudales de misericordia, el que ayuna no cosechará fruto alguno.

Tú que ayunas, piensa que tu campo queda en ayunas si ayuna tu misericordia; lo que siembras en misericordia, eso mismo rebotará en tu granero. Para que no pierdas a fuerza de guardar, recoge a fuerza de repartir; al dar al pobre, te haces limosna a ti mismo: porque lo que dejes de dar a otro no lo tendrás tampoco para ti.”

Que Dios les bendiga con renovadas fuerzas en esta Cuaresma.




