Pastor's Letter / Carta del Párroco

Dear parishioners,

It is always encouraging to see new initiatives blossoming within our parish, particularly when they originate from families connected with our parish and school. This week, I would like to share some news with you from one of our Aquinas families who are currently attending Saint John Paul the Great High School. A few weeks ago, I had the privilege of blessing a new centre located very close to our parish: Gracewood Senior Living. I truly believe this is an inspired initiative with a meaningful origin story.

Gracewood Senior Living was born from a deeply personal place. The house that now serves as Gracewood was where the Yu family started their lives together, raised their children, and welcomed their grandparents when they came to visit from the Philippines. After losing their maternal grandparents within two years of each other (the grandmother in September 2023 and the grandfather in April 2025), the family felt the deep ache of time passing too quickly and ending too soon. They are missed every day in the smallest of moments, and the family often wishes for just a little more time together. It was through this loss that the family felt called to create a place where families might have more opportunities to be present with one another when it matters most. What was once our family home has now become a place where life and love continue to flourish in a new and meaningful way. It was very moving to bless each room in the house, which has now been completely transformed, and to learn from the family members how those spaces were used before they moved out to create Gracewood Senior Living. Today, we need facilities that look like homes to help those who first prepared a home for us!

We all understand that many adult children today must balance caring for their aging parents with raising their own families. This is a time that requires deep devotion and love. Gracewood exists to support these families. In our 24-hour, personalized, home-like setting, with a caregiver-to-resident ratio of one to four, we ensure that seniors are safe and supported with dignity. Our hope is that loved ones can focus on being loving family members, giving meaningful time and attention to their elderly relatives. Gracewood provides medication management, assistance with daily activities, home-cooked meals, and meaningful companionship, to name a few. Our goal is simple: to help families feel confident and at peace knowing their loved ones are cared for. Residents, on the other hand, need to feel valued and truly at home. Gracewood is never a facility, but a true home built on respect, patience, and love. I am grateful that we have such a breath of fresh air in our neighborhood. The house may be small, but it certainly feels like home.

It is inspiring to see how this initiative serves our elders within the walls that have always meant so much to the Yu family. May God bless Jonathan Yu, Shamin Chua-Yu and their daughters, Corinne and Harley.

May we all continue to expand our works of mercy,

Pastor's Letter / Carta del Párroco

Queridos feligreses:

Siempre es alentador ver cómo surgen nuevas iniciativas en nuestra parroquia, sobre todo cuando provienen de familias vinculadas a nuestra parroquia y a nuestra escuela. Esta semana me gustaría compartir con ustedes una noticia de una de nuestras familias de Aquinas cuyos hijos estudian actualmente en el instituto Saint John Paul the Great. Hace unas semanas, tuve el privilegio de bendecir un nuevo centro situado muy cerca de nuestra parroquia: Gracewood Senior Living. Creo sinceramente que se trata de una iniciativa inspiradora con una historia de profundo significado.

Gracewood Senior Living surgió de una experiencia profundamente personal. La casa que ahora alberga Gracewood fue el lugar donde la familia Yu comenzó su vida juntos, crió a sus hijos y acogió a sus abuelos cuando venían de visita desde Filipinas. Tras perder a sus abuelos maternos con dos años de diferencia (la abuela en septiembre de 2023 y el abuelo en abril de 2025), la familia sintió el profundo dolor de que el tiempo pasara demasiado rápido y terminara demasiado pronto. Se les echa de menos cada día en los momentos más insignificantes, y la familia a menudo desea disponer de un poco más de tiempo juntos. Fue a raíz de esta pérdida que la familia sintió el llamado a crear un lugar donde las familias pudieran tener más oportunidades de estar presentes unas con otras cuando más importa. Lo que una vez fue nuestro hogar familiar se ha convertido ahora en un lugar donde la vida y el amor siguen floreciendo de una forma nueva y significativa. Fue muy emotivo bendecir cada habitación de la casa, que ahora se ha transformado por completo, y conocer de boca de los miembros de la familia cómo se utilizaban esos espacios antes de que se mudaran para crear Gracewood Senior Living. Hoy en día, necesitamos instalaciones que parezcan hogares para ayudar a aquellos que fueron los primeros en prepararnos un hogar.

Todos sabemos que, hoy en día, muchos hijos adultos deben compaginar el cuidado de sus padres mayores con la crianza de sus propias familias. Es un momento que exige una profunda dedicación y amor. Gracewood existe para apoyar a estas familias. En nuestro entorno acogedor, personalizado y disponible las 24 horas del día, con una ratio de un cuidador por cada cuatro residentes, nos aseguramos de que las personas mayores estén seguras y reciban apoyo con dignidad. Nuestra esperanza es que los seres queridos puedan centrarse en ser familiares cariñosos, dedicando tiempo y atención significativos a sus parientes mayores. Gracewood ofrece gestión de la medicación, asistencia en las actividades diarias, comidas caseras y compañía significativa, por nombrar algunos servicios. Nuestro objetivo es sencillo: ayudar a las familias a sentirse seguras y tranquilas sabiendo que sus seres queridos están bien cuidados. Los residentes, por su parte, necesitan sentirse valorados y verdaderamente como en casa. Gracewood no es en absoluto un centro, sino un verdadero hogar construido sobre el respeto, la paciencia y el amor.

Estoy agradecido de que contemos con este soplo de aire fresco en nuestro barrio. La casa puede ser pequeña, pero sin duda se siente como un hogar. Es inspirador ver cómo esta iniciativa atiende a nuestros mayores dentro de las paredes que siempre han significado tanto para la familia Yu. Que Dios bendiga a Jonathan Yu, Shamin Chua-Yu y a sus hijas, Corinne y Harley.

Que todos sigamos ampliando nuestras obras de misericordia,
